Canfranc Station: Forward Escape, *El Paso* (Thriller, Adventure) by David Moreno, Raúl López and Diego Sotelo

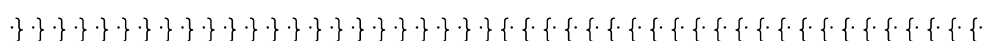
Ex Reo (Thriller) by María Mínguez (DLO Productions)

They will be presented by their authors on June 21 in the pitching session of Conecta FICTION. This presentation will improve the visibility of the projects and enable their authors to meet with producers, commissioners and investors who may be interested in coproducing and/or financing their development afterwards.

The pitching session will feature the special collaboration of Alberto Vázquez, talented animation director, illustrator and cartoonist. Vázquez's books have been published, in addition to Spain, in countries such as France, Italy, Brazil and Korea. He is regularly published as an illustrator in magazines such as EL PAIS, La Voz de Galicia, Vanity Fair, Communication Arts or Boston Globe magazine. Alberto Vázquez has won three Goya awards, the last two in 2017 for the best animated film "Psiconautas" co-directed with Pedro Rivero and for the best animated short "Decorado".

Conecta FICTION is the first international event that has been exclusively dedicated to the coproduction of fictional television series between Europe, Latin América and the spanish speaking public of the United States. The first edition will be celebrated in Santiago de Compostela between the 20th and the 23rd of June, and is organized by the Axencia Galega das Industrias Culturais (Agadic) of the Galicia's Xunta government, ICEX Exportation and Investments Spain, the SGAE Foundation, and is produced by Inside content.

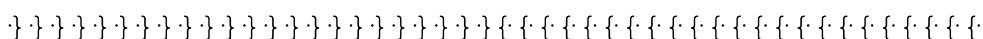
