



Movistar+ will present its original series RIOT POLICE in Conecta FICTION Reboot

Madrid, May 28, 2020. - On Tuesday June 16, Movistar+ will present its new original series RIOT POLICE as part of the virtual edition of Conecta FICTION, which will be held online from June 15 to 18. There will also be an on-site edition on September 2 to 3, 2020, in Pamplona-Iruña, Navarra (Spain).

The series RIOT POLICE is an action thriller in 6 episodes of 50 minutes per episode (6x50'). This is a Movistar+ Original Series in collaboration with The Lab and Caballo Films. The online presentation in Conecta FICTION Reboot will be its first contact with the international markets. It will involve the participation of Domingo Corral, director of original productions of films and series of Movistar+, Sofía Fábregas, executive producer of The Lab Cinema, and the Oscar® nominee Rodrigo Sorogoyen, cocreator and director of the series. He is also one of the most awarded creators of the Spanish cinema. This series is currently in post-production and will premiere in Spain through Movistar+ next autumn 2020.

Conecta FICTION Reboot will be the starting point of RIOT POLICE international journey, a fast-paced action series distributed by Movistar+ that aims to reach a worldwide audience. As stated by Nicolas Lecocq, Chief of Distribution of Original Productions of Movistar+, "RIOT POLICE is a fast-paced series from the beginning to the end. Rodrigo Sorogoyen proves again that he has a special ability to create a human portrait framed by gripping action. Movistar+ invests in a series that aims to bring into the open an unknown facet of a collective that is usually a victim of many prejudices. The narration and rhythm of RIOT POLICE will engage a varied international audience."

Six riot police carry out an eviction in the center of Madrid that becomes over-complicated. An Internal Affairs team is tasked with investigating the facts. Laia, the only woman on the team, becomes obsessed with the case and ends up discovering that behind this failed eviction there is a network of real estate corruption that spills over into the upper echelons. The riot squad members look for their own way out but that ends up separating them and eventually complicating their situation even further. Laia and the riot police become unlikely partners and together they will risk everything to uncover a criminal plot that has been going on in Madrid for years.

RIOT POLICE stars Raúl Arévalo, Roberto Álamo, Hovik Keuchkerian, Álex García, Raúl Prieto and Patrick Criado, the six riot police officers of the POLICE TRACK 9, and Vicky Luengo, as the Internal Affairs inspector in charge of the investigation.

Meanwhile, and due to exceptional circumstances, the on-site event moves to September 2020 and will include the presentation of the projects selected for the different pitching sessions of Conecta FICTION 4. The fourth edition of Conecta FICTION will be held in the Baluarte, Congress Center and Auditorium of Navarra, in Pamplona-Iruña (Navarra, Spain), on September 2 to 3, 2020.

The fourth edition of **Conecta FICTION** has the support of the government of Navarra through NICDO (Navarre Infrastructure of Culture, Sport and Leisure) and SODENA (Society for the Development of Navarre) and the SGAE Foundation, and is receiving cooperation from CLAVNA (The Audiovisual Cluster of Navarre) and NAPAR (Navarre Association of Producers and Audiovisual Professionals).
