#### ACCREDITATION TO THINK TANK WORKSHOP - June 18th,2024. CONECTA FICTION & ENTERTAINMENT, 8<sup>th</sup> EDITION ACCREDITATIONS TERMS

#### 1. Introduction and subject-matter

1.1. These contracting and privacy conditions (hereinafter "the Accreditations Terms") regulate the accreditation and participation in the THINK TANK workshop, held in the framework of the 8<sup>th</sup> Edition of the event "Conecta FICTION & ENTERTAINMENT", international exchange meeting between producers, authors and other participants around the television fiction and entertainment that will be held in Toledo, Castilla-La Mancha (Spain), from June 18th to 21th, 2024 (the "Event"). Full Event information is available on the website www.eventconecta.com (the "Website").

Conecta THINK TANK is a new space for reflection on the future of fiction and entertainment production for television, which will be held on June 18<sup>th</sup> at Puy du Fou España, a unique park located in the heart of nature, which allows you to travel through history. The participants will also attend a meal in a hall adjacent (hereinafter, the "THINK TANK Workshop"). The program and contents of the THINK TANK Workshop are published on the Connect FICTION & ENTERTAINMENT website (the "Program"). Likewise, they will be sent by email to those interested in participating.

1.2. The person responsible for the contractual offer is INSIDE CONTENT, S.L. (the "Organizer"), a company incorporated under the Spanish law, with registered office in Clara del Rey, n° 4, 5°-dcha, 28002 Madrid, Spain, and VAT. B-87731972, registered in the Mercantile Register of Madrid to volume 35592, folio 110, section 8, page number M-639687, and with email: <u>accreditation@insidecontent.tv</u>.

1.3. The assistant to the THINK TANK Workshop is the person who, meeting the following requirements, duly register for the THINK TANK Workshop (hereinafter referred to as the "Assistant to the Workshop").

Requirements to be accredited in the THINK TANK Workshop:

- (i) the Assistant to the Workshop shall be accredited previously for attending the Event;
- (ii) be a professional or executive of an audiovisual company;
- (iii) have full capacity to enter into binding contracts.

Depending on capacity, the Event reserves the right to accept or not attendees from the same company.

1.4. The acceptance of these Accreditations Terms is a necessary condition to perform the accreditation in the THINK TANK Workshop. In any case, the possession by the Assistant to the Workshop of an accreditation for the THINK TANK Workshop automatically implies the assumption of these Accreditations Terms.

#### 2. Features

The accreditation of the Assistant to the Workshop will give him the right to participate in the THINK TANK Workshop, including the enjoyment of the activities, meals and transfers described in the Program.

#### 3. Conditions of accreditation

3.1. The accreditation in the THINK TANK Workshop can be done until June 8th, 2024, or until filled to capacity. The accreditation can be requested via <u>Google Form</u>, with the sole criterion of the Organizer being the acceptance of applications.

3.2 The accreditation process in the THINK TANK Workshop is carried out following the steps below:

- Submit the application via the <u>Google Form</u> published on the website.
- Confirmed the participation the Assistant to the Workshop shall accept these Accreditations Terms in order to continue the process.
- Accepted the Accreditations Terms the system will redirect to the payment gateway PAYPAL where it will be possible to make the payment by credit card. In default of PAYPAL payment can be made by bank transfer to the account number the Organizer that will be provided by email to the Assistant to the Workshop requesting it so to <u>accreditation@insidecontent.tv</u>.
- Once the payment is accepted, the Assistant to the Workshop will receive an email confirming his/her accreditation in the THINK TANK Workshop. In case of payment by bank transfer, the Assistant to the Workshop must send proof of the transfer made to the email <u>accreditation@insidecontent.tv</u> and, upon receiving the transfer, will receive an email confirming his/her accreditation in the THINK TANK Workshop.
- 4. Prices and payment

4.1. Accreditation prices in the THINK TANK Workshop are published on the Website. Unless expressly stated otherwise, these prices do not include VAT, provided that this tax is applicable.

4.2. The Organizer may unilaterally revise and modify the prices posted on the Website.

In any case, before final payment is made, the Assistant to the Workshop will be informed of the final price of the accreditation, which will be appropriate to the information provided at that time on the Website.

4.3. Payment will be made by credit or debit card. To make the payment, the Assistant to the Workshop will be redirected to the PAYPAL payment gateway, where credit or debit card details shall be provided to make the payment.

4.4. Charges will be made on the credit card at the time of the accreditation, which will be confirmed at the time of confirmation of payment. In case the charge has not been possible for any circumstance, the accreditation will not be considered confirmed.

4.5. To access the THINK TANK Workshop, and, as the case may be, to the complementary activities, the Assistant to the Workshop must present his Badge.

**4.6.** If the Assistant to the Workshop needs an invoice, he/her must request it by sending an email to the e-mail address indicated in section 1.2 of these Accreditations Terms.

# 5. Right of withdrawal, policy of changes and cancellation of accreditations and cancellation of the THINK TANK Workshop

5.1. Pursuant to article 103 of Royal Legislative Decree 1/2007, of November 16, approving the Consolidated Text of the General Law for the Defense of Consumers and Assistant to the Workshops and other complementary laws, it will not be applicable to this contract the right of withdrawal. Not being able to attend the THINK TANK Workshop is not a reason to terminate this contract and does not give Assistant to the Workshop the right to reimbursement of any amount or cost.

5.2. The Assistant to the Workshop may request changes regarding his/her accreditation (eg. change in the person who will attend the THINK TANK Workshop), by means of an e-mail to the email address indicated in section 1.2, no later than June 8th, 2024, included. The Organizer reserves the right to accept or deny such changes. If the requested change is accepted, the Organizer will send an email to the Assistant to the Workshop confirming the change made. No change request received after June 8th, 2024, will be considered.

5.3. The Organizer will only accept cancellation of accreditations when the request for cancellation is received by the Organizer in writing, to the e-mail address indicated in section 1.2 of these Accreditations Terms, before June 8th, 2024. In such case it will be refunded to the Assistant to the Workshop 50% of the amount paid by the latter for his/her accreditation, by bank transfer, within a maximum period of 30 days from the end of the Event.

Cancellation of accreditations will not be accepted and refunds of payments for accreditations will not be made, for whatever reason, from June 8th, 2024.

5.4. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to or to have expelled, temporarily or permanently, any Assistant to the Workshop whose presence, conduct or behavior threatens the image, peace or safety of the THINK TANK Workshop and/or of the other participants in the THINK TANK Workshop and/or of the Organizer and/or the integrity of the facilities where it is held. In such case, the Assistant to the Workshop shall be reimbursed the price already paid for the accreditation on a pro rata basis according to the time remaining from expulsion to the end of the THINK TANK Workshop.

5.5 In the case of cancellation of the THINK TANK Workshop, the Organizer will refund to the Assistant to the Workshop the amount satisfied by the accreditation in the shortest possible time and in any case within a maximum period of 30 days from the communication of the cancellation.

### 6. Customer Support

6.1. The Assistant to the Workshop may make any inquiries regarding his/her accreditation to the Event by sending an email to the address stated in section 1.2.

## 7. Protection of personal data

7.1. The data provided by the Assistant to the Workshops through the Accreditation Form (being obligatory, to carry out the accreditation, to facilitate those marked with an asterisk) as well as those obtained in connection with other activities carried out in or related to the Workshop, will be treated under the responsibility of INSIDE CONTENT, S.L.

7.2. The collection and processing of data is intended to manage the accreditation, attendance and participation of the Assistant to the Workshop in the THINK TANK Workshop, as well as to send to Assistant to the Workshop information, promotions and publicity and other commercial or non-commercial communications related to the Event and newsletters, to update the Organizer's records, to display and manage contents and communications with the Assistant to the Workshop, to respond to communications made by the Assistant to the Workshop and to comply with any legal requirements and will be processed by INSIDE CONTENT, S.L. to the extent necessary to meet those needs. The Assistant to the Workshop authorizes INSIDE CONTENT, S.L. to keep and process its personal data for the purposes described above for the future editions of Conecta FICTION & ENTERTAINMENT.

7.3. The credit or debit card data that the Assistant to the Workshop uses for the payment of his/her credit will be provided directly to PAYPAL; the Organizer does not have access to such information.

7.4. The Assistant to the Workshop guarantees that the data provided are correct, committing to communicate to the Organizer changes on those data. In case the Assistant to the Workshop provides the required data incompletely or inaccurately, the Organizer does not guarantee the accreditation; only the Assistant to the Workshop responds of the consequences derived from the provision of inaccurate data.

7.5. The Organizer guarantees the confidentiality of the personal data provided by the Assistant to the Workshops, according to the provisions on the rules applicable to the Protection of Personal Data and Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce, except as set out below.

7.6. The Organizer informs Assistant to the Workshop that the identification and contact details provided for the accreditation may be communicated to the collaborating entities in the Event and to those suppliers that manage access and/or provide services to the Event related to the attendance and participation of Assistant to the Workshops in the Event, solely for the purpose of facilitating such management and provision of services.

7.7 The Organizer reserves the right to use recorded images and photographs of the Workshop including several or all participants, as well as the conclusions drawn from the reflections, for public communication and marketing purposes, among others.

7.8. The Assistant to the Workshop may contact the Organizer in order to freely exercise his/her rights of access, to rectification, to erasure, to object, to data portability and to restriction of processing with regards to the data incorporated in its files. To do so, Assistant to the Workshop shall send a written requirement to the Organizer, by registered mail to Calle López de Hoyos 64, 1°E, Madrid 28002, Spain, or to the email address accreditation@insidecontent.tv, specifying the right that he/she wishes to exercise, accompanied by a copy of an official document that identifies him/her. In any case, INSIDE CONTENT may keep a copy with the data duly blocked, as long as responsibilities for this agreement can be derived.

7.9. The Assistant to the Workshop shall have the right to lodge a complaint with the Spanish Agency for Data Protection (AEPD) in the case that Assistant to the Workshop understands that any of its rights related to data protection have been breached.

7.10 The press attending the Conference will not be allowed to divulge data and information of the Workshop, except with the express authorisation of those attending the Workshop, or of the Organisation. The organisers reserve the right to limit the participation of the press in the Workshop, depending on the availability of places.

#### 8. Liability

8.1. The Organizer declines any liability that could be derived from an incorrect use by the Assistant to the Workshop of the online purchase procedure.

8.2. Any liability for any damages caused by third parties that are not attributable to the Organizer is also disclaimed.

8.3. The Organizer will not be responsible in case of interruptions, delays, errors and, in general, other inconveniences that have their origin in causes that are beyond the control of the Organizer, and/or due to a negligence or willful misconduct of the Assistant to the Workshop and/or has its origins due or Unforeseen circumstances.

### 9. Severability and amendment of the Accreditation Terms

9.1. Should any of the clauses of these Accreditations Terms prove to be invalid, void or unenforceable for any reason, such condition shall be excluded and shall not affect the validity or applicability of the remaining conditions.

9.2 The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to these Accreditations Terms. The modifications will be applicable to the accreditations purchased after their publication on the Website.

9.3 The Organizer reserves the right to decide on all matters not regulated in these Accreditations Terms and to add to these Accreditations Terms the clauses convenient to regulate such matters, which will be immediately applicable from their publication on the website of Conecta FICTION & ENTERTAINMENT. The Organizer will notify such new conditions to the accredited Assistant to the Workshops when it deems it necessary in view of the incidence of the same in their participation in the Event.

#### 10. Applicable law and forum

The relationships established between the Assistant to the Workshop and INSIDE CONTENT will be governed by Spanish law. The Assistant to the Workshop and the Organizer, expressly waiving any other jurisdiction that may correspond to them, will submit any controversies and/or litigation to the Courts of Madrid, Spain.
